
Processing your recycled printer cartridges






It all starts with you!

By regularly recycling your used printer toner and cartridges at work or via our retail collection points, you're helping a recycling process that ensures zero waste ends up in landfill. Product stewardship initiatives, like Cartridges 4 Planet Ark, help keep valuable materials in use whilst also protecting the environment.





We take care of the rest

Once collected, the cartridges are manually sorted at the Close the Loop facility in Melbourne

Cartridges can be returned for recycling through all Officeworks and Office National outlets, and at participating Australia Post, Harvey Norman, JB Hi-Fi and The Good Guys stores. Your workplace can apply for a free collection box if you use more than 3 cartridges a month.



Some cartridges are returned to their original manufacturers for reuse or recycling.

Other cartridges are crushed and the materials separated.
